Minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting
Tuesday October 19, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 6:03pm via Zoom. In attendance were Mayor Sherry Tyler and Commissioners Brad King, Gary Osborne, Carol Huelsman, and Gayle Wilhelmi. Carrie was given the evening off as there were no legal questions of the agenda. The minutes of the September meeting and the budget report were distributed through email prior to the start. Gary made a motion to approve the minutes. Brad seconded and the motion was passed.

Old Business: Brad ordered and received the new "speed humps ahead" sign with the reflexive surface. The cost was around \$68, but it did not come with any hardware. Sammy thinks he has what is required and will install the sign soon.

All tax bills are paid, therefore no liens are necessary.

Andy Reynolds at Waste Management has not communicated any updates as far as the new recycling containers. We did get the credit for the altered schedule of recycling and yard waste pickup. The alternating weekly schedule for recycling will continue through November 15 although yard waste will be collected every week now.

Sherry has asked Carrie to send a letter to Mr. Poole about his house under construction on Browns Lane regarding the status of the property. He has not given any updates to Sherry although he did fix the immediate issues we were concerned about.

New Business: Sherry shared that she received an email from Beth Wallace on Westfield. Beth wanted us to be aware that they and several neighbors have been having an issue with rats. Five houses on the street have seen evidence of rats and they have killed many with rat traps. Beth did call 311 and the person the city sent out only offered to set out poison, which is dangerous to dogs should a dog catch a rat that has been poisoned. They preferred not to use poison but to stick with rat traps. If a food source could be identified and eliminated that would help to get rid of them.

Sherry received an invitation to a JCLC dinner to honor all female mayors as part of the observance of the 100th anniversary for the right of females to vote. The dinner will be held on the evening of November 18 with the reception starting at 5:30pm and the dinner at 7:00. Heather French Henry will be the speaker and reservations are due by November 12. The dinner will be held at the Jeffersonian on 10607 Taylorsville Rd. past Watterson Trail.

With no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 6:30pm. The next meeting will be November 16, 2021 at 6:00pm.
